"The rooms are not huge," Harmon said. "They're comfortable. The library is about 18 by 13 feet."

Traditional in style, the house itself is simple but features unusual elements such as an old mantel that was found in a flea market and the concrete countertop in the kitchen.

"I wanted the house to look old,"

Harmon said.
